Rype's mission is to lead a new category of high-quality office furniture that radically reduces carbon emissions and waste, and is lower cost


Our furniture comes from:

- Remanufacturing¹ high quality unwanted furniture (from clients and/or office clearances) to as-new condition using quality-controlled engineering processes.
- Creating sustainable new furniture, made by social enterprises including the Merthyr Tydfil Institute for the Blind, which incorporates sustainable materials like recycled post-consumer waste plastic.

Our free award-winning free design service integrates all furniture and reclaimed/surplus flooring into beautiful, productive and healthy offices. We also enjoy working with other designers, offering sustainability advice on furniture, flooring and electronics.

Our projects generate **social value** by using local suppliers and local trades including upholsterers, polishers, powder coaters and carpenters and we engage and train local long term unemployed with disabilities – to whom we pay at least Real Living Wages.

¹ Remanufacturing takes the long-life elements of an item (like steel frames), checks and resurfaces them, and then rebuilds the piece around them. The resulting furniture looks and performs as new.



For delivery and installation we are partnered with Connection Crew, a Community Interest Company helping **homeless** individuals back into employment.

Remanufacturing has significant **environmental benefits**, reducing embodied energy, greenhouse gas emissions, materials use, water use and biodiversity loss due to raw material extraction by 80%.

We quantify these benefits for clients in a **Sustainability Report** at the end of a project, showing cost savings, tonnes of waste avoided, embodied carbon emissions avoided and hours of employment for those furthest from the workforce.
