Background

Danusha is a graduate civil engineer. She had always wanted to work in the construction industry, however, as a recently trained engineer with family commitments, she was unable to gain experience in the industry, and as a result has spent several years working in the education sector.

Barriers

Danusha qualified in engineering 13 years ago. She felt that her skills had become outdated over the years, and coupled with her lack of experience, she found it very difficult to proceed.



Intervention

Danusha attended the WIC/Wates information session in September 2022, where she received information about the different routes into the industry. Danusha took part in the 5-weeks programme where she renewed her CSCS card through CONEL College and received the academically qualified persons card, then took part in a 2-weeks placement with Wates. She really enjoyed and appreciated the opportunity to understand the world of construction work. To her delight, she was offered an apprenticeship as a Construction Site Supervisor with Wates Drylining Service after completing her 2-weeks work placement. She accepted and started the role in November 2022 and is delighted to have this opportunity to refresh and update her knowledge while working and attending college.
